 - *Super-hidden tables*

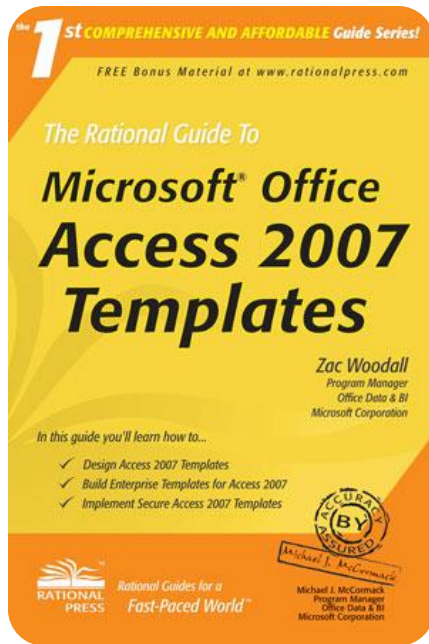
